Take your waste in the designated bag to the collection area 8:30 a.m. on the collection day.

Inashiki City (Azumza area)

- Each household may take up to five bags of combustible waste to the collection point each collection day.

It's against the law to leave recyclables with other waste! Tie the designated bag and place it in the designated area.

## Category **Example items Disposal method** Cloth, leather waste Wood, branches **Plastic products** Stained containers • Remove excess liquid from kitchen refuse. Harden excess cooking oil or soak it up with paper or cloth. Leftover food, grass, Clothing, shoes, bags CD cases Mayonnaise containers Woodchips, small Disposable lighters Small branches must be no more than 50cm in length and 5cm in thickness and tied up in bundles Combustible when left at the collection point. However, to dispose of more than five bundles at once, please bring them to a collection center. waste Paper diapers must have excrement removed before disposal. Plastic products without a recycle mark, tissue paper, toilet paper, and post displaying personal information are classified as combustible waste. **Empty bottles Glass** Remove the caps from empty bottles and rinse them with water. **Bottles**, glass Cups, glass sheets, (Metal and plastic caps must be disposed of separately.) Liquor, beer, Wrap broken items like glass in newspaper or something similar when disposing of them to prevent injury. soft drink bottles bulbs, light bulbs **Empty cans** Small household electronics **Metals** Porcelain and earthenware \* It is dangerous to make holes in spray cans. Soft drink cans, gas cylinders for tabletop Rice cookers, telephones, Small bowls, plates Spray cans and gas cylinders for tabletop stoves can explode, so always make sure they are completely empty. hair dryers, toasters, etc. as, frying pans, dry cell s, hot water/hot drink pots clay pots Metals Wrap sharp objects like blades in newspaper or something similar when disposing of them to prevent injury. toves, spray cans, Please make sure cans are empty and rinse them with water. Some small household appliances can also be disposed of in boxes at certain collection points. 1৩ই Item that fit into this category are marked with this symbol. **Bottles** Film Packs, cups, etc. Caps Polystyrene **Trays Plastic** These items must be emptied, rinsed with water and then drained. Generally collected at collection points. PET bottles are also collected on the collection day for containers plastic containers and packages. See the "PET bottles" section for disposal method. and packages All caps should be removed for safety (including PET bottle caps). Dispose of any plastic products that are permanently or badly stained and any products that are made of plastic but are not a container or packaging as combustible waste. Item that fit into this category are marked with this symbol. Paper cups Paper bags Paper cartons, etc. **Paper** • Please remove anything attached to plastic waste if it is not paper. If it cannot be removed, dispose of the item containers as combustible waste. Products processed with aluminium (the back side will be silver colored) should be disposed of as and cartons Dispose of any paper product that is badly stained as combustible waste. Dispose of by folding and putting into piles no more than 50cm in length or width and binding with Newspapers, Fliers Magazines Cardboard Newspapers, (Newspaper and fliers may also be disposed of in paper bags from newspaper delivery shops.) magazines, Make each bundle about 30cm tall. cardboard Bundle newspapers (fliers), magazines and cardboard separately. Remove plastic book covers from books. Item that fit into this category are marked with this symbol. The following items are not accepted PET bottles that ■ Plastic sheets for agriculture ■ Industrial refrigerators, ■ Ash ■ Motorcycles, tires, car batteries PET bottles contained soft drink ■ Fire extinguishers ■ Polystyrene (for industrial use) ■ Propane gas containers vending machines soy sauce, mirin. ■ Concrete, cinder blocks ■ Bricks ■ Medical waste ■ Roofing tiles (including thatched ■ New building materials sauces, dressings ■ Waste oil, paint roofing) ■ Trash containing asbestos (plasterboard, insulation, etc.) ■ Power cables, TV cables ■ Sinks, bathtubs, toilets Remove the cap and label, rinse with water, then crush. \*Check the Waste Classification Guidebook or contact us to inquire about items not listed above that do not fit clearly into a category.
